POLICY: ENROLMENT

1. Rationale:

To ensure students have access to neighbourhood schools and the freedom to choose other schools subject to facility limitations.

2. Policy:

- Eligible children have the right to be placed in their neighbourhood school.
- We will endeavour to limit Chilwell's enrolment to 350 (subject to School Operations Manual and DET Policy).
- The Regional Manager has the authority to effect placement of students.

Neighbourhood school :

The designated neighbourhood school is the school that is nearest the student's permanent residence, unless the Regional Manager :

- needs to restrict new enrolments at a school
- has designated the neighbourhood boundaries for the school.

The designated boundaries are : *Refer map attached.*

<u>Enrolment Boundaries:</u>	
South Boundary:	Barwon River
East Boundary:	La Trobe Terrace - (from Barwon River to Aberdeen Street)
West Boundary:	Shannon Avenue - (from Barwon River to Aphrasia Street)
North Boundary:	Aphrasia Street to Talbot Street → Talbot Street to Retreat Road → Retreat Road to Manning Street → Manning Street to Skene Street → Skene Street to Pakington Street → Pakington Street to Aberdeen Street → Aberdeen Street to La Trobe Terrace. →

Priority order :

- 2.1 Students for whom Chilwell is the designated neighbourhood school.
- 2.2 Students with a sibling at the same permanent address currently enrolled at Chilwell and children of permanent staff members at the school.
- 2.3 Provisional enrolments will be accepted on the following basis :
 - 2.3.1 Geographic - ie. in order of proximity to the school measured in a straight line from the student's residence.
 - 2.3.2 In exceptional circumstances, compassionate grounds as directed by the Regional Manager.
- 2.4 If enrolment is sought during the school year, placement will follow guidelines as set out above. Children outside the neighbourhood boundary will be admitted if a position at the particular grade level exists and the total enrolment is less than 350.
