PARENT PAYMENT 2018

Dear Parents, February 2018.

The Department of Education and Training, through our Student Resource Package, allocates Chilwell a Teaching Support Grant which enables us to provide some curriculum materials and administrative support for classroom and specialist programs. However, despite careful planning by the School Council's Finance Committee, we are unable to provide the current range and quality of educational programs without a direct contribution from parents.

The staff and council are most appreciative of the strong community support for fundraising activities throughout past years. The level of support through fundraising will still rely heavily on the annual Chilwell Fair. The monies raised through parent financial contributions will provide for essential items for your child and development of our facilities. Your payment will ensure Chilwell Primary School maintains a stimulating, varied and well resourced learning environment for all students.

Parents are responsible for providing, or paying the school to provide, essential education items such as personal stationery, textbooks, materials for learning and teaching where the student takes possession of the finished article; and costs associated with excursions they are expected to attend.

ARE YOU ON A HEALTH CARE OR PENSIONER BENEFIT CARD?? - CAMPS, SPORTS, EDUCATION FUND (CSEF):

The CSEF allowance for 2018 is \$125.00 for all year levels. This payment is provided by the Department of Education and Training to assist eligible families with the costs associated with camps and excursions attended of their children. You will need to make an application at the school office. Please note: Applicants must hold a health care or pensioner benefit card which is required to be presented when completing the Application form.

ESSENTIAL EDUCATIONAL ITEMS: Required to be paid for each student

In accordance with the 'Parent Payments in Victorian Government Schools' directives, our Essential Educational charge covers items which parents/guardians pay the school to provide, or may provide themselves if appropriate. These items are essential to support instruction in the standard curriculum program and include materials that the individual student takes possession of, such as text books and student stationery, materials for learning and teaching where the student consumes or takes possession of the finished articles, (eg. Art Program)
